WINTERFEST Expectations

I have two main expectations. I have to mention the rest, but if you follow these, we'll be fine.

#1: I will behave in such a way that it would be best if everyone acted just like me.

#2: I will remember WHO and WHOSE I am.

- 1. No boys are allowed in the girls motel rooms and no girls are allowed in the boys motel rooms at any time.
- 2. From 12:00 a.m. to 6:30 a.m. you must stay in your own motel room.
- 3. You must tell your assigned chaperone where you will be if you leave your motel room. You must stay in groups of 2 or more when you go to another motel room or to the motel lobby. No teenager should leave their motel room alone. Teens will not have room keys, so you will need to check with an adult before returning to your room.
- 4. You can only leave the motel at <u>designated times</u> when the whole group goes to the Convention Center, to Gatlinburg or to Pigeon Forge. You must stay in groups of at least THREE when you leave the motel for scheduled activities. ALL Middle Schoolers are to be with an adult during FREE TIME.
- 5. Due to the busy schedule at Winterfest and because it is difficult to provide adequate supervision at the pool, no one will be allowed to go swimming at the motel.
- 6. You must show respect for and obey the adult chaperones.
- 7. You <u>must</u> be on time for activities. Listen carefully to instructions about where to meet and when to meet with our group. When our group meets in the lobby at the motel, in the Convention Center, etc. you must check in with your assigned chaperone. You are expected to attend ALL planned WINTERFEST activities.
- 8. You *cannot* leave the Convention Center during scheduled activities.
- 9. Do not lose your Winterfest pass (badge). It will cost you \$10.00 to purchase another one. When you leave your motel room in the morning, be certain that you bring your Winterfest pass, your jacket, wallet or purse, money, any medication, or whatever you will need for the rest of the day.
- 10. If you or another teenager gets sick or injured or if you have a problem, notify your assigned chaperone or David Skidmore as soon as possible. (You will be given Skid's Cell # to locate them in the case of emergency.)
- 11. Be considerate of people in your room, people in adjoining rooms and people in the rooms below you. Be quiet in the hallways. Don't slam doors, yell or jump on the beds. You must pay for any damage you cause in any motel room.
- 12. No one is allowed to *bring*, *purchase*, *or use* cigarettes, e-cigarettes (or tobacco of any type), alcoholic drinks or illegal drugs. No one is allowed to bring or use fireworks, weapons, laser lights or laser pointers.
- 13. All electronic equipment (gaming devices, iPods, etc.) may be used on the ride BACK ONLY, but must be left in the motel room once in Gatlinburg. Please choose appropriate music. We reserve the right to listen to what you bring. We want teens to use the ride up for getting to know those who are with them. We know that teens are tired on the way back, so we will allow them to listen to music on the way home.
- 14. Remember at *all* times (by what you say and do) to be a good example and to bring honor to God, your family and the family of God at North Boulevard.

I have gone over these rules with my teenager. I understand that if my child does not obey these rules I will be contacted by phone, and I may have to come to Gatlinburg to pick up my child.
